## Active Travel Fund 3 – A461 Great Bridge to Peake Drive – Pedestrian and cycle facilities improvement works

As you are aware Sandwell Metropolitan Borough Council proposes to undertake the pedestrian and cycle improvement works on Horseley Heath and Dudley Port as part of the Active Travel Fund from Central Government. Bridge Construction Limited have been awarded the Contract and work is expected to commence over the next few weeks and anticipated to be completed by July/August.

## These proposals are:

- Upgrade the existing traffic signals junction at Horseley Heath and Horseley Road.
- Install a new pedestrian/cycle crossing near the junctions of Scott Street and Providence Street.
- Upgrade the existing traffic signals junction at Lower Church Lane and Dudley Port.
- Upgrade the existing pedestrian crossing near the junction with John's Lane.
- Install a new pedestrian/cycle crossing near the junction with Station Drive
- Relocation of bus shelters.
- 1.2km of two-way segregated cycle tracks on A461 from Great Bridge to Peake Drive.

During the construction of the proposals it will be necessary to implement temporary footway and carriageway restrictions to carry out the works safely. However, access to frontages will be maintained throughout the works. The contractor will be in contact with you regarding the timing of the works outside your property / premises.

We will endeavour to complete the works with the minimum of disruption that economy of operations and safety will allow. I hope you will appreciate that unfortunately some inconvenience is unavoidable, and your co-operation and patience would be much appreciated.
