Brades Village SPD Area Boundary Existing community uses and private recreation space.

New strategic open space and green links.

New residential opportunities for average densities between 50/75 dph.

New residential opportunities for average densities between 40/50 dph.

Through road connections to be designed to link existing road network. The design should discourage the potential for rat running and restrict vehicle speeds.

- New internal road layout to provide connected residential structure.
- Potential pedestrian and cycle link to improve access to local facilities.
- Existing internal road connections.

Landmark opportunities.



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Infill opportunity for new residential development to face onto and enclose the Ashtree Road frontage.

Built form should be designed to visually reinforce key nodes within the new residential layout and at key entrance points.

- Improvements to canal frontage (in consultation with with British waterways).
- • Improvements to canal towpath to ensure easy pedestrain/cycle access (in consultation with British Waterways).
 - New built form to overlook canal and improve natural surveillance.
- ▲ ▲ New development to face onto and integrate with existing street network.

New development should be orientated to back onto and secure the rear of existing back garden areas and conceal poor views.

Limited opportunities for direct vehicular access. New residential layout to overlook Strategic Green Open Space.

Potential to connect new development and Hillbank with a pedestrian connection only to improve access to local facilities for existing and new residents.

Substantial levels difference falling from Ashtree Road into the site.

Potential environmental \sim enhancement works.

Potential to connect green spaces with green links.

New development should face onto new street frontages and primary existing street frontages Brades Rise, Brades Road, Dudley Road East and Lower City Road

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
