Following a hearing on 26/02/2025 (a review hearing of the Injunction granted by the Honourable Mr Justice Julian Knowles on 27/02/2024) at which the injunction was order to continue, a directions order was made which, principally, detailed a list of service steps the Claimants were required to undertake to bring the injunction (in its amended form) and ancillary orders, to the attention of the public at large, thereby effecting service on Persons Unknown.

Per paragraph 6 of the directions order of the Honourable Mr Justice Julian Knowles (as amended on 07/03/2025), once the service steps were complete within 7 days of completion of those steps, the Claimants were required to file a witness statement evidencing compliance with those steps and upload it to their Websites.

On 25/03/2025, Paul Brown, Communications Manager of the First Claimant, Wolverhampton City Council, made a witness statement with details of the service steps taken and an exhibit comprising supporting evidence, which respectfully asserted, as evidenced in his statement, that the Claimants had complied with the service steps set out in the directions order of the Honourable Mr Justice Julian Knowles (as amended on 07/03/2025) by 21/03/2025. This was Mr Brown's 23rd witness statement in these proceedings.

Direction 6 of the directions order of the Honourable Mr Justice Julian Knowles (as amended on 07/03/2025) thus required Mr Brown's 23rd witness statement to be filed at court and uploaded to the Claimants' Websites by 4.00 p.m. on 28/03/2025.

Mr Brown's 23rd witness statement was duly filed at Court by the First Claimant, via CE-File, on 25/03/2025 at 15.27 hours. The First Claimant sent an e-mail on 25/03/2025 at 13.55 hours to its contacts at all four Claimant Councils attaching a copy of Mr Brown's 23rd witness statement and exhibit and requesting that this be uploaded to each of the Claimants' Websites by 16.00 hours on 28/03/2025. At 10.14 hours on 28/03/25 a further e-mail was sent by the First Claimants to its contacts at all four Claimants reminding them of the deadline of 16.00 hours that day for uploading of Mr Brown's 23rd witness statement to their Websites.

During the course of 28/03/2025, confirmation was received by the First Claimant's in-house Litigation Team (Legal Services) that each of the First, Second and Third Claimants had duly uploaded the 23rd witness statement of Paul Brown to its respective Website between 25 and 28 March thus complying with the directions order of the Honourable Mr Justice Julian Knowles (as amended on 07/03/2025). Unfortunately, the Fourth Claimant, Walsall Metropolitan Borough Council, did not upload the 23rd witness statement of Paul Brown to its Website until 01/04/2025.

To comply with the order, the 23rd witness statement of Paul Brown was to be uploaded to the Claimants Website by close of business 28/03/25 (within 7 days of completion of the service steps). The Claimants make full admission that the witness statement was not uploaded in time, as not all Claimant parties had actioned this by 28/03/25. The witness statement was uploaded to all the Claimants Websites in full on 02/04/2025.

The Claimants will respectfully contend the slight delay in uploading the witness statement of Paul Brown to their Websites has caused no prejudice to those affected or potentially affected by the Injunction, nor has it in any way adversely affected the operation of the Injunction.

The Claimants duly apologise for their failure to comply with the term of the amended directions order requiring upload of Paul Brown's witness statement to their Website by 28/03/25. The Claimants also emphasise that despite this minor infringement, they nevertheless completely respect and will always use their best endeavours to comply with orders of the Court.
