Registration Services What to do when someone dies



All deaths in England and Wales are independently scrutinised, either by a Medical Examiner (ME), who is a senior medical doctor or are referred to a coroner.

MEs are supported by Medical Examiner Officers (MEOs), and their independent scrutiny includes a review of medical records, discussions with the doctors who are completing the Medical Certificate of Cause of Death (MCCD) and also discussion with the family.

If the cause of death is not natural or not clear the death will be referred to the coroner.

Occasionally, urgent funeral arrangements might be necessary. In this instance services in Sandwell will look to support families in any way they can. Outside normal working hours, out of hours provision is available. **Out of hours provision:**

Medical Examiner's Office – The Doctor completing the MCCD can call **0121 553 1831** ask for the on-call Medical Examiner - Every weekend and Bank Holiday excluding Christmas Day between 9am and midday.

Coroner – The Coroner is available on weekends and Bank Holidays to deal with Out of England requests between 10am and 1pm excluding Christmas Day. Contact with the Coroner will be made via the on-call Registrar.

Death Occurs

Death occurs at hospital or hospice/care home. Medical Practitioner will confirm end of life and inform family Death occurs at home – contact deceased GP or NHS helpline on 111 to confirm end of life. Death occurs at any other location. If the death was unexpected it is

Death is registered, Green Certificate is issued to the chosen Funeral Director to enable funeral arrangements to be made. Or by exception, handed to the family them informed of progress. When the inquest concludes the coroner will issue paperwork to the Register Office to enable the death to be registered. Family do not need to attend. When the registration is completed the register office will contact the family to arrange for the purchase of certificates if required and complete tell us once.
