# Statutory declaration and renunciation forms

### What is a Statutory declaration?

The statutory declaration exists to ensure that burial and memorial rights are exercised by the rightful person when there is no owner available or if the deeds have been lost. This helps to protect both the owner of those rights and the council. It is used by most burial and cremation authorities in England and is supported by the Institute of Cemetery and Crematorium Management. If there is a Will please call us on 0121 569 6707 as a separate form may be required.

#### Form of renunciation (page two)

This section of the form is to be signed by anyone of equal kinship i.e. brother/sisters/cousins etc. to the person who will be completing the Statutory Declaration. The signatures on this page can be witnessed by anyone who knows the person.

#### **Order of succession (page three)**

The order of succession is to be used as guidance to identify the rightful person to exercise the burial and memorial rights. If there is more that one person of equal kinship i.e. three brothers and/ or sisters then **all will have to sign the form**.

It is up to the family to identify one person to sign and complete page one.

The order of succession always starts with the original grave owner.

### Statutory declaration (page four)

This section is to be completed by the **one person** who will be granted permission to arrange a burial and/or memorial in/on the grave.

This section of the form needs to be signed in front of a J.P. or Commission of Oaths.

#### **Deeds**

If you send in original deeds these will be updated to acknowledge the new registered owner and returned to the person who completed page four.

If no deed is produced new deeds will be issued for the remainder of the initial lease when the Statutory Declaration has been accepted .

General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR): The personal data provided to Sandwell Metropolitan Borough Council Bereavement Services in this form, is collected and will be managed in accordance with Data Protection Legislation, and is collected solely for the purposes of processing the request for bereavement services, in respect of the deceased person named. # Order of succession for the applicant for exclusive right of burial when grave owner is deceased

5. Whole blood brothers and sisters of the deceased
6. Whole blood nephews and nieces of the deceased
7. Half blood brothers and sisters of the deceased
8. Half blood nephews and nieces of the deceased
9. Grandparents
10. Whole blood uncles and aunts of the deceased
11. Children of whole blood uncles and aunts of the deceased (full cousins)
12. Half blood uncles and aunts of the deceased
13. Children of half blood uncles and aunts of the deceased (half blood cousins)
14. Other persons with an interest in the estate may apply
