This form must be completed in full and submitted along with any supporting information (photographs will help speed up the Council's response and can be used as evidence against any unauthorised structures/works/change of uses/untidy land (including buildings)).

These details may be shared with other Council and Government departments dependant on the nature of your complaint.

This application record will be retained forever in the event that formal enforcement proceedings are instigated and when a breach is either resolved or found to be lawful development or use of the land it will be retained for four years (unlawful development) or ten years (unlawful use).
