## Temporary Prohibition of Causeway Green Road, Oldbury

The Borough Council of Sandwell hereby gives Notice that on 4<sup>th</sup> June 2025 no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along Causeway Green Road, Oldbury which will be closed one-way in a north easterly direction from the junction of the Wolverhampton Road to the dividing line of properties 211/213 (access to any affected frontages will be maintained, but only when safety permits).

A traffic diversion route will be signed via Wolverhampton Road (north bound), Birchley Island, Churchbridge, Oldbury Ringway, Seven Stars Road, Park Lane, Station Road, Crosswells Road, Vicarage Road, Joinings Bank and New Henry Street.

A further traffic diversion route will be signed via Wolverhampton Road (south bound), Pound Road, Moat Road, Joinings Bank and New Henry Street.

The purpose and reason for the issue of this Notice is to facilitate access for emergency electrical service repairs by Doocey Group on behalf of National Grid Electricity Distribution.

This Notice will remain effective and in force from 4<sup>th</sup> June 2025 and for a period not exceeding 21 days. It is anticipated that the work will be completed by 4<sup>th</sup> June 2025.
