- Improve the availability and quality of Alternative Provision for children with and without unidentified SEND through the development of a Vulnerable Learners Pathway
- Deliver the Strengthening Skills and Employment Strategy to improve access to employment and training opportunities

- 1. % of children achieving a Good level of development in the Early Years Foundation Stage
- 2. % Educational attainment for all pupils at the Expected level or above in reading, writing and maths at Key Stage 2
- 3. % EHCP 20 week completion rate
