- Friar Park Road, adj. to house numbers 97 & 99: 3.5; 1.8; 75.

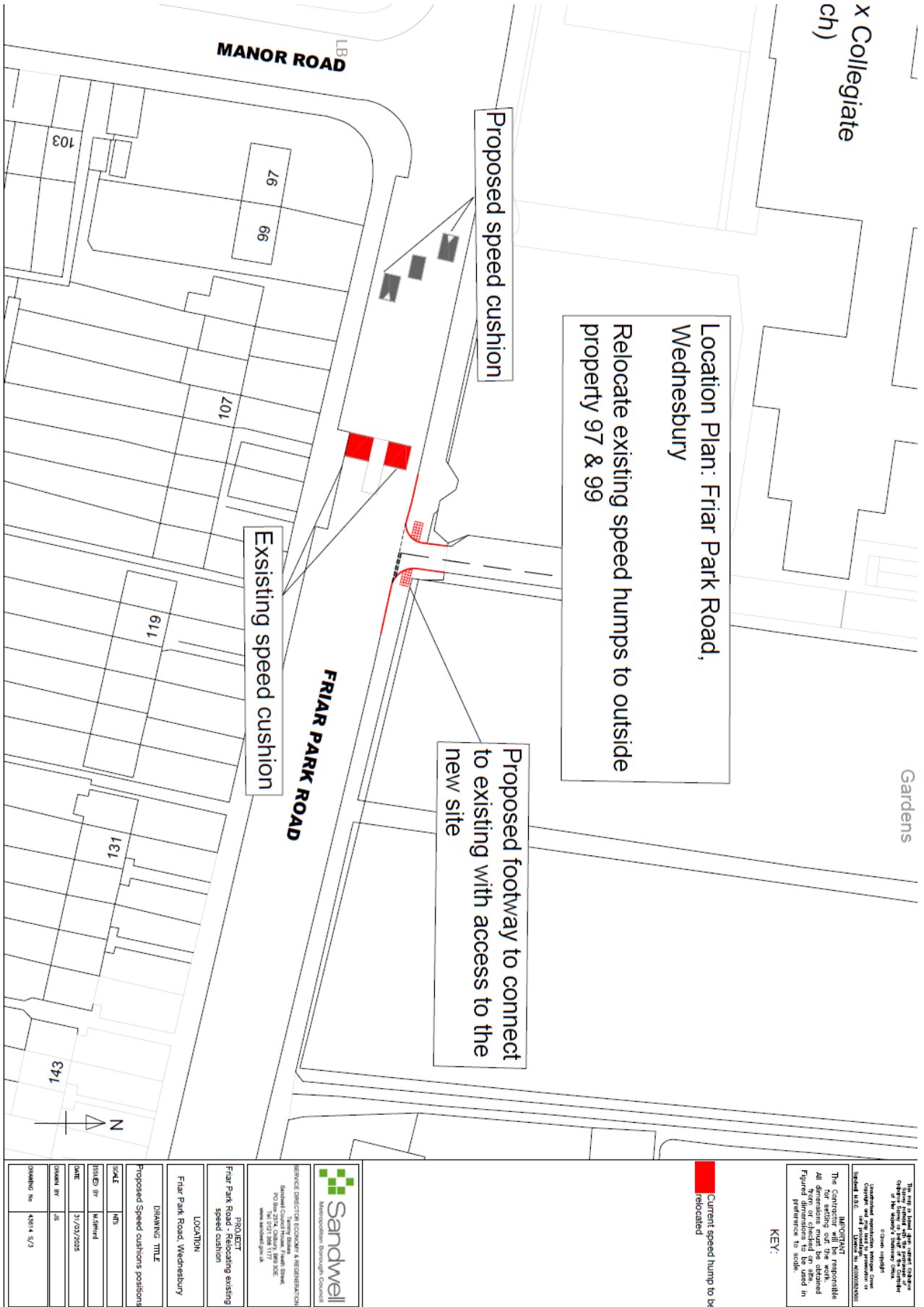
