

SANDWELL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL TOWN POLICE
CLAUSES ACT 1847 THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF SANDWELL
(REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY PARADES)
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VARIOUS ROADS) ORDER 2025

Notice is hereby given that on the 9th November 2025, the Borough Council of Sandwell in exercise of its powers provided by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, and after informing the Chief Officer of Police intends to make the following Order:

On Sunday 9th November 2025, between the hours of 9.30am and 1.30pm, no person shall cause any vehicle, except for a vehicle being used by the Police, Ambulance Service or Fire Brigade and parade vehicles, to proceed along the following lengths of roads:

OLDBURY

Low Town, for its entire length.

Birmingham Street from its junction with Low Town to its junction with Halesowen Street

Halesowen Street from its junction with Birmingham Street to the point where it meets Church Street

Church Street from the point where it meets Halesowen Street to its junction with Oldbury Ringway / Bromford Road

Freeth Street from its junction with Oldbury Ringway to Oldbury Civic Square.

WEST BROMWICH

Congregation Way, from its junction with the most northerly traffic island on Congregation Way to its junction with Reform Street

Reform Street, from its junction with Congregation Way to its junction with New Street North.

ROWLEY REGIS

Spring Meadow, for its entire length

Highgate Street from its junction with Halesowen Road Traffic Island to the point where it meets Garratts Lane

Garratts Lane from the point where it meets Highgate Street to its junction with Powke Lane

Powke Lane Island for its gyratory

Moor Lane at its junction with Powke Lane

SMETHWICK

Coopers Lane, from its junction with Green Street to its junction with High Street

High Street, from its junction with Coopers Lane to its junction with Newlands Green

GREAT BARR

Chapel Lane from the A34 Birmingham Road to the Borough Boundary.

WEDNESBURY

Church Hill from its junction with Ethelfleda Terrace to its junction with High Bullen

High Bullen from Trowse Lane Traffic Island to the point where it meets Walsall Street

Walsall Street from the point where it meets High Bullen to its junction with Hydes Road

Hollies Drive, for its entire length.

Hydes Road from its junction with Walsall Street to its junction with Brunswick Park Road

TIPTON

Albion Street from its junction with Owen Street to its junction with Union Street.

New Cross Street from its junction with Albion Street to its junction with Downes Court

Union Street from its junction with Albion Street to its junction with Waterloo Street.
Waterloo Street from its junction with New Street to its junction with Wellesley Drive
Waterloo Street East from its junction with Waterloo Street to its junction with Queen's Road.
Queen's Road from its junction with Manor Road to its junction with Park Lane East

A no waiting or loading restriction (Blue badge parking exempt) will be operational on Victoria Road, Tipton (West side) between Park Street and Compton Road – 07.00hrs – 13.00hrs.

Any road abutting the roads prohibited to vehicular traffic stated above may also be prohibited for vehicles to access or exit for the duration of the parades.
