ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF SANDWELL (FIGHTING FROM HOME MEMORIAL
SCULPTURE UNVEILING) (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES, CRADLEY
HEATH) ORDER 2025**

In order to facilitate the unveiling of a statue commemorating those noncombatants fighting from home during the First and Second World Wars, the Borough Council of Sandwell in exercise of its powers under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and after informing all other enabling bodies intends on 6th November 2025 to make the following Order: -

1. Except as provided in Clauses 2, 3 and 4 below, on 9th November 2025 (13.30hrs – 15.30hrs), no person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed along or the following roads in Cradley Heath:

Newtown Lane (High Street – Upper High Street)
Upper High Street Bus Gate
Corngreaves Road (High Street – Pennant Road)
High Street (Prince Street – Corngreaves Road)

2. The provisions of Clause 1 shall not apply to any motor vehicle which is being used by the Police, Ambulance Service or Fire Brigade in pursuance of their statutory powers and duties.
3. The provisions of Clause 1 shall not apply to any motor vehicle which is being used by a statutory undertaker in an emergency such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water in the area which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into the roads specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
4. The provisions of Clause 1 shall not apply to anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a Constable in uniform.
5. In this Order “motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

This Order may be cited as The Borough Council of Sandwell (Fighting from Home memorial sculpture unveiling) (Temporary Road Closures, Cradley Heath) Order 2025.
