1. **Bikeability** – Level 1 & 2 is a one-day course for Years 5 and 6, delivered to 6 riders each day. Pupils start on the playground and progress out onto local roads. They develop their cycling skills and road safety knowledge, whilst gaining a sense of independence and learning skills that can improve their physical and mental wellbeing.

From September 2025, Bikeability cycle training will be delivered as an opt-out course. This means that all pupils can take part, unless their parent / guardian notifies school otherwise. Bike Right can provide all equipment, including bikes and helmets if required.

Schools can win prizes for participating in Level 1 / 2 Bikeability training sessions:

- **£250 voucher** – schools will be entered into a **half-termly draw** if at least 80% of booked pupils participate in Level 1/2
- **£50 voucher** – for **all schools** where at least 95% of booked pupils participate in Level 1/2
