SANDWELL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough Council of Sandwell (Station Road, Titford Road and Trinity Street, Oldbury) (Temporary Road Closures) and (Broad Street to Trinity Street) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2025 intends to temporarily prohibit vehicles from proceeding along Station Road, Titford Road and Trinity Street as detailed below.

Access to any affected frontages within the road closures will be maintained, but only when safety permits.

Trinity Street – closed between the junctions of Park Lane to Station Road (5th – 6th January 2026). Traffic will be diverted via Crosswells Road, Vicarage Road, Tat Bank Road, Western Road and vice versa.

Station Road – closed from the junction of Trinity Street for a distance of 30 metres ($5^{th} - 6^{th}$ January 2026). Traffic will be diverted as above.

Station Road – closed from the junction of Trinity Street for a distance of 35 metres (6th January 2026). Traffic will be diverted via Crosswells Road, Vicarage Road, Joinings Bank, New Henry Street, Langley Green Road, Langley High Street, Broad Street and Titford Road.

Trinity Street – closed between the junctions of Titford Road and Station Road (6th January 2026). Traffic will be diverted as above.

Titford Road – closed from the gable end of property number 41 to the junction with Park Lane $(7^{th} - 8^{th})$ January 2026).

The order intends to temporarily prohibit pedestrians from proceeding along the link footpath leading from **Broad Street to Trinity Street**, which will be closed (6th January 2026).

A pedestrian diversion route will be signed via Whyley Walk, Station Road and vice versa.

The maximum duration for the phased closures is 18 months but the work is expected to be completed by 09/01/2026 effective from 05/01/2026.

Purpose – to facilitate access for carriageway and footpath reinstatement defect repairs by Cadent Gas Ltd.
