Temporary Prohibition of Queens Road and Severn Close, Tipton

The Borough Council of Sandwell hereby gives Notice that on 10th November 2025 no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along Queens Road, Tipton, which will be closed one-way in a westerly direction from the gable end of property number 34 to the junction of Manor Road (eastern side) and Severn Close, Tipton, which will be closed at the junction of Queens Road (access to any affected frontages will be maintained, but only when safety permits).

A traffic diversion route will be signed via Victoria Road, Mayfair Gardens and Park Lane West.

The purpose and reason for the issue of this Notice is to facilitate access for emergency sewer works by Severn Trent Water.

This Notice will remain effective and in force from 10th November 2025 and for a period not exceeding 21 days. It is anticipated that the work will be completed by 14th November 2025.
