Notice is hereby given that the Council has made **The Borough Council Of Sandwell (Sandwell Borough, Consolidation of Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Traffic Regulation Order 14) (Amendment Order 4) 2026**: under Sections 1, 2, 4 and 9 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”) and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act as an experimental order which will have the effect of introducing the following amendments:-

- Introduce / Amend No Waiting At Any Time upon Halesowen Street, High Street, Long Lane, Oldbury Road, Park Street West and Short Street (Rowley Regis)
- Introduce Bus Gate upon Market Place (Rowley Regis)
- Introduce / Amend Limited Waiting Parking Bays upon Halesowen Street and Short Street (Rowley Regis)
- Introduce / Amend No Loading During Prescribed Hours upon High Street, Park Street West and Short Street (Rowley Regis)
- Introduce / Amend Loading Only During Prescribed Hours upon Long Lane and Park Street West (Rowley Regis)
- Introduce / Amend Parking Bays for Disabled Badge Holders upon Long Lane (Rowley Regis)
- Introduce No Stopping During Prescribed Hours upon Birmingham Road, Halesowen Street, High Street, Long Lane, Market Place, Oldbury Road and Park Street West (Rowley Regis)

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Full details on this legal order may be examined at Sandwell Council House, Freeth Street, Oldbury, West Midlands, B69 3DE during normal office hours or via the Council’s website.

The Order was made on the 18th February 2026 and shall come into effect on the 25th February 2026 for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of its operation.

That within a period of 6 months:-

- (a) Beginning with the day on which the Order came into force, or (b) if the Order has been varied by another Order or modified beginning with the day on which the variation or modification of the latest variation or modification came into force.**

Any person may object to the making of an Order for the purposes of such indefinite continuation.
