## THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF SANDWELL

### (Sandwell Borough, Consolidation of Waiting and Loading Restrictions)

#### (Traffic Regulation order No. 14) (Amendment Order 4) 2026.

The Borough Council of Sandwell ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 45 and 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and under the Road Traffic Act 1991 as amended (whether generally or in relation to the area of the Council) ("the 1991 Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1 This Order may be cited as The Borough Council of Sandwell (Sandwell Borough, Consolidation of Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Traffic Regulation Order No.14) (Amendment Order 4) 2026 and shall come into operation on
  - i) Any reference to a statutory or non-statutory provision shall also refer to its successor in title for as long as that power is delegated to the Council.
- 2 The restrictions imposed by this order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under any other enactment.
- 3 In this Order -
  - a) "Approved Device" has the same meaning as in the Bus Lanes (Approved Devices (England) (Order) 2005 (as amended)
  - b) "Authorised person" means an employee or agent of the Council authorised to exercise all or any of the functions of the Council under this Order.
  - c) "Bus" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the 2016 Regulations.
  - d) "Bus Lane" means any area of road which is or forms part of a road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order, that may only be used by Buses, Taxis and Pedal Cycles and has the same meaning as in part 2 of Schedule 7 of the Traffic Management Act 2004; and Schedule 1 of the 2016 Regulations.
  - e) "Bus Only Street" has the same meaning as Bus Lane
  - f) "Business" means one which is registered for Business Rates.
  - g) "*Civil Enforcement Officer*" means an Authorised person by or on behalf of the council to enforce the restrictions in this Order and issue Penalty Contravention Notices,
  - h) "Council" means Sandwell Metropolitan Borough Council or its successor in title
  - i) "*driver*" in relation to a motor vehicle waiting in a parking area, means the person driving the motor vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place.
  - j) "*electronic communications network*" has the same meaning as in the Communications Act 2003.
  - k) "*goods vehicle*" means a motor vehicle not exceeding 2.3m in height or 5.25m in length, which is constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods or of burden of any description and is not drawing a trailer.
  - l) "*household*" means the occupants of a dwelling used or suitable for use as a separate dwelling.
  - m) "*junction*" means the intersection of the outside edge of the first highway with the outside edge of the second highway.

- n) *"Motor cycle"* has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
  - o) *"Motor vehicle"* has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
  - p) *"Owner"* in relation to a vehicle, means the person by whom such vehicle is kept and used. In determining who was the Owner at any time it shall be presumed that the Owner was the person named in the vehicle registration document as the registered keeper of the vehicle or the person who has the use of such vehicle in the course of his/her employment and which is entitled to use such vehicles as though he/she were the registered keeper. Owner shall have the meaning in the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 in respect of a person who is served a penalty charge notice
  - q) *"Pedal Cycle"* has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the 2016 Regulations
  - r) *"penalty charge"* has the same meaning as in the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 or any subsequent legislation so enabling;
  - s) *"penalty charge notice"* means a notice issued by a civil Enforcement Officer pursuant to The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Approved Devices, Charging Guidelines and General Provisions) (England) Regulations 2022 and the provisions of part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004.
  - t) *"taxi"* has the meaning given by Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
  - u) *"the 2016 Regulations"* means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016
  - v) *"traffic sign"* means a sign of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
  - w) *"universal service provider"* has the same meaning given by Section 65(1) of the Postal Services Act 2011.
- 4 Every Vehicle left in a Parking Place in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Order shall stand so that every part of the Vehicle is within the marked limits of that Parking Place.

## Section 1: No waiting at any time

- 1/01.** Subject to the provisions of this section no person shall, except upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform or of a uniformed Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to wait at any time in the sides and lengths of roads referred to in **Schedule 1** to this Order.
- 1/02.** For the purposes of **Clause 1/01**, a Motor Vehicle shall be taken to wait on a length of road if -
- i)** the Motor Vehicle is stationary; and
  - ii)** any point in that length of road is below the vehicle or its load (if any).
  - iii)** "For the purposes of **Clause 1/01**, a further contravention shall be created if the Motor Vehicle remains on a length of road specified in **Schedule 1** of this Order, it will be considered a new contravention from midnight on a rolling/daily basis.
- 1/03.** Nothing in **Clause 1/01** of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to wait as specified therein for so long as may be reasonably necessary -
- (a)** to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b)** to enable the vehicle to be used for the purposes of -
    - i)** any building operation, demolition or excavation;
    - ii)** the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - iii)** the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
    - iv)** the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunication system lawfully kept installed in any position;
    - v)** the collection of household refuse from, or the cleaning of cesspools at, premises situated on or near the sides and lengths of roads specified in **Schedule 1** of this Order;
  - (c)** to enable a vehicle, which is a universal service provider for the collection or delivery of postal packets in the course of a universal postal service.;
  - (d)** to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle over a reasonable timeframe;
  - (e)** to enable a Motor Vehicle to be used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority, parking attendant / Civil Enforcement Officers or water authority, sewage authority and national rivers authority purposes, when used in pursuance of their statutory powers or duty.
- 1/04.** Nothing in Clause 1/01 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a Motor Vehicle which displays in the relevant position, a valid disabled person's badge and a parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the Motor Vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the sides of lengths of road referred to in Schedule 1 for a period not exceeding 3 hours (provided that this waiting is not during a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same Motor Vehicle in the same sides of lengths of road).

## Section 4: Bus Lane

- 4/01.** Subject to the provisions of this section, no person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle other than a Bus and Pedal Cycle to enter or proceed in the Bus Only Street specified in Schedule 4 at any time in the sides and lengths referred to in **Column 2** in **Schedule 4** of this order
- 4/02.** Nothing in **Clause 4/01** of this order shall apply to any person causing a Motor Vehicle to enter or proceed on a bus only street where:-
- (a)** A motor vehicle where the person in control of the Motor Vehicle:-
- i)** The removal of any obstruction to traffic
  - ii)** Is required by law to stop
  - iii)** Is obliged to enter the Bus Only Street to avoid an accident or to avoid injury or damage to property
- (b)** To enable the vehicle to be used for the purposes of -
- i)** any building operation, demolition or excavation;
  - ii)** the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
  - iii)** the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
  - iv)** the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunication system lawfully kept installed in any position;
  - v)** the collection of household refuse from, or the cleaning of cesspools at, premises situated on or near the sides and lengths of roads specified in **Column 2** in **Schedule 4** of this Order;
  - vi)** The placing, maintenance or removal of any street furniture
  - vii)** The placing, maintenance or removal of a traffic sign
  - viii)** Undertaking works on the public highway and authorised to be in the Bus Only Street by the Council whilst undertaking specific works
- Provided that in all circumstances it is necessary for the motor vehicle to enter the Bus Only Street.**
- (C)** To enable a Motor Vehicle to be used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority, parking attendant/civil enforcement officers or water authority, sewage authority and national rivers authority purposes, when used in pursuance of their statutory powers or duty.
- (D)** The Council will carry out civil enforcement of any contravention of any prohibitions, restrictions or provisions of this section by permitting the imposition of a Penalty Charge Notice on the basis of a record produced by the means of an Approved Device

## Section 5: Limited waiting during prescribed hours

- 5/01.** Subject to the provisions of this section, no person shall, except upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform or of a uniformed Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to wait in the sides and lengths of roads referred to in **Schedule 5** to this Order during the hours prescribed in Column 5 of the said schedule -
- (a) for a period exceeding the length of time specified in **Column 6** of **Schedule 5**;
  - (b) during any period separated by an interval of less than the duration specified in **Column**
- 5/02.** For the purposes of **Clause 5/01**, a Motor Vehicle shall be taken to wait on a length of road if-
- i) the Motor Vehicle is stationary; and
  - ii) any point in that length of road is below the vehicle or its load (if any)
  - iii) "For the purposes of **Clause 5/01**, a further contravention shall be created if the Motor Vehicle remains on a length of road specified in **Schedule 5** of this Order at the beginning of a period in which vehicles may be left there in pursuance of the order and shall be treated as if it had been left there at the beginning of that period "
- 5/03.** Nothing in **Clause 5/01** of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait as specified therein for so long as may be necessary -
- (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) to enable the vehicle to be used for the purposes of-
    - i) any building operation, demolition or excavation;
    - ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
    - iv) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunication system lawfully kept installed in any position;
    - v) the collection of household refuse from, or the cleaning of cesspools at, premises situated on or near the sides and lengths of roads specified in **Schedule 5** of this Order;
  - (c) to enable a vehicle which is a universal service provider for the collection or delivery of postal packets in the course of a universal postal service.
  - (d) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
  - (e) to enable a Motor Vehicle to be used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority, parking attendant/civil enforcement officers or water authority, sewage authority and national rivers authority purposes, when used in pursuance of their statutory powers or duty.
- 5/04.** Nothing in **Clause 5/01** of this Order shall apply to a vehicle that is displaying in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge.

## Section 6: No Loading and Unloading during prescribed hours

- 6/01.** Subject to the provisions of this section, no person shall, cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to be loaded or unloaded in the sides and lengths of roads referred to in **Schedule 6** to this Order during the hours prescribed in **Column 5** of the said schedule.
- 6/02.** For the purposes of **Clause 6/01**, a Motor Vehicle shall be taken to wait on a length of road if-
- i)** the Motor Vehicle is stationary; and
  - ii)** any point in that length of road is below the vehicle or its load (if any)
  - iii)** "For the purposes of **Clause 6/01**, a further contravention shall be created if the Motor Vehicle remains on a length of road specified in **Schedule 6** of this Order at the beginning of a period in which vehicles may be left there in pursuance of the order and shall be treated as if it had been left there at the beginning of that period."
- 6/03.** Nothing in **Clause 6/01** of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to wait as specified therein for so long as may be necessary -
- (a)** to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b)** to enable the vehicle to be used for the purposes of-
    - i)** any building operation, demolition or excavation;
    - ii)** the removal of any obstruction to traffic;

  - (c)** to enable a vehicle which is a universal service provider for the collection or delivery of postal packets in the course of a universal postal service.
  - (d)** to a Motor Vehicle which is stationary to enable it to be used for the purposes of the collection and delivery of monies, provided that vehicles referred to in this paragraph shall be only those security vehicles which have been specially authorised, made or adapted for that purpose;
  - (e)** to enable a Motor Vehicle to be used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority, parking attendant / Civil Enforcement Officers or water authority, sewage authority and national rivers authority purposes, when used in pursuance of their statutory powers or duty.

- 7/01.** Subject to the provisions of this section, no person shall, except upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform or of a uniformed Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to wait in the sides and lengths of roads referred to in **Schedule 7** to this Order during the hours prescribed in **Column 5** of the said schedule except for the purposes of loading and unloading.
- 7/02.** For the purposes of **Clause 7/01**, a Motor Vehicle shall be taken to wait on a length of road if-
- i)** the Motor Vehicle is stationary; and
  - ii)** any point in that length of road is below the vehicle or its load (if any)
  - iii)** "For the purposes of **Clause 7/01**, a further contravention shall be created if the motor vehicle remains on a length of road specified in **Schedule 7** at the beginning of a period in which vehicles may be left there in pursuance of the order and shall be treated as if it had been left there at the beginning of that period."
- 7/03.** Nothing in **Clause 7/01** of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait as specified therein for so long as may be necessary -
- (a)** to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with-
    - i)** any building operation, demolition or excavation;
    - ii)** the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
    - iii)** the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunication system lawfully kept installed in any position;
    - iv)** the collection of household refuse from, or the cleaning of cesspools at, premises situated on or near the sides and lengths of roads specified in **Schedule 7** of this Order;
  - (b)** to enable a Motor Vehicle to be used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority, parking attendant / Civil Enforcement Officers or water authority, sewage authority and national rivers authority purposes, when used in pursuance of their statutory powers or duty.

- 8/01.** Subject to the provisions of this section, no person shall, except upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform or of a uniformed Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to wait in the sides and lengths of roads referred to in **Schedule 8** to this Order during the hours prescribed in **Column 5** of the said schedule.
- 8/02.** For the purposes of **Clause 8/01**, a Motor Vehicle shall be taken to wait on a length of road if-
- i)** the Motor Vehicle is stationary; and
  - ii)** any point in that length of road is below the vehicle or its load (if any)
  - iii)** "For the purposes of **Clause 8/01**, a further contravention shall be created if the motor vehicle remains on a length of road specified in **Schedule 8** of this Order at the beginning of a period in which vehicles may be left there in pursuance of the order and shall be treated as if it had been left there at the beginning of that period."
- 8/03.** Nothing in **Clause 8/01** of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any Motor Vehicle that displays a valid disabled person's badge in the relevant position, and a parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the Motor Vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the sides and lengths of roads referred to in **Schedule 8** to this Order for a period not exceeding the length of time specified in **Column 6** of **Schedule 8**.
- 8/04.** Nothing in **Clause 8/03** of this Order shall apply to any motor vehicle waiting in the sides and lengths of roads referred to in **Schedule 8** to this Order during a period separated by interval of less than the duration specified in **Column 7** of **Schedule 8** from a previous period of waiting by the same motor vehicle in the same side and length of road
- 8/05.** Nothing in **Clause 8/01** of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait as specified therein for so long as may be necessary -
- (a)** to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b)** to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with-
    - i)** any building operation, demolition or excavation;
    - ii)** the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - iii)** the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
    - iv)** the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunication system lawfully kept installed in any position;
    - v)** the collection of household refuse from, or the cleaning of cesspools at, premises situated on or near the sides and lengths of roads specified in **Schedule 8** of this Order;
  - (c)** to enable a vehicle which is a universal service provider for the collection or delivery of postal packets in the course of a universal postal service.
  - (d)** to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
  - (e)** to enable a Motor Vehicle to be used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority, parking attendant / Civil Enforcement Officers or water authority, sewage authority and national rivers authority purposes, when used in pursuance of their statutory powers or duty.

## Section 14: Red Route No stopping during prescribed hours

### General prohibition of stopping

- 1** Subject to the provisions of this section no person shall, except upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform or of a uniformed Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to stop at any time in the sides and lengths of roads referred to in **Schedule 14** to this order, during the hours prescribed in **Column 5** of the said schedule.
- i)** "For the purposes of **1**, a further contravention shall be created if the motor vehicle remains on a length of road specified in **Schedule 14** continuing the contravention, it will be considered a new contravention from midnight on a rolling/daily basis.

### Miscellaneous exemptions for parking

- 2** **(1)** The controls specified in clause 1 do not apply in respect of a person causing a vehicle to stop if that person is-
- (a) required by law to cause the vehicle to stop or not to proceed;
  - (b) obliged to stop the Motor Vehicle so as to avoid an accident;
  - (c) prevented from proceeding in the Motor Vehicle by circumstances beyond the person's control;
  - (d) getting or giving help in consequence of an accident or an emergency, or otherwise taking action for public safety;
  - (e) opening or closing a gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises to which the Motor Vehicle is being driven or from which it has emerged if it is not reasonably practicable to cause the vehicle to stop elsewhere for the purpose;
  - (f) to enable a Motor Vehicle to be used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority, parking attendant / Civil Enforcement Officers or water authority, sewage authority and national rivers authority purposes, when used in pursuance of their statutory powers or duty.
  - (g) using the Motor Vehicle in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
  - (h) using the Motor Vehicle in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any length of road specified in **Schedule 14**;
  - (i) using the vehicle under a licence under section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 to stop for so long only as may be required to enable a passenger to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (j) using a Motor Vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position to stop for so long only as may be required to enable a disabled person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (k) using the Motor Vehicle for the purpose of collecting refuse by or on behalf of a local authority;
  - (l) using a Motor Vehicle which bears the livery of a universal service provider which is waiting at the edge of a carriageway for so long as may be necessary for the purposes of the provision of a universal postal service (as defined in the Postal Services Act 2011).
- (2)** The controls specified in clause 1 of this Order do not apply to anything done with the permission of an authorised person or with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or of a uniformed Civil Enforcement Officer.

- (3) The controls specified in clause 1 of this Order do not apply in respect of a person causing a pedal cycle to be parked at a facility specifically provided for the purpose of pedal cycle parking by, or with the consent of the highway authority.

**Exceptions at bus stops and stands**

- 3. (1) The controls specified in clause 1 do not apply in respect of a person causing:
  - (a) a bus to stop within a red route bus stop clearway for as long as may be required to enable passengers to board or alight; or
  - (b) a bus in the provision of a local service to stop within a red route bus stop or bus stand clearway if being used for operational reasons or training drivers to allow such a service to be provided.
- (2) In this article "operational reasons" means:
  - (i) to enable passengers to board or alight;
  - (ii) to enable crew changes to take place;
  - (iii) to maintain the scheduled timetable subject, in the case of a red route bus stop clearway, to a maximum wait of two minutes.
