

**SANDWELL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – Section 14 2**

Temporary Prohibition of Victoria Street, Wednesbury

The Borough Council of Sandwell hereby gives Notice that on 1st April 2026 no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along Victoria Street, Wednesbury, which will be closed between the junctions of Potters Lane and Stafford Street.

A traffic diversion route will be signed via Potters Lane, Bridge Street, Holyhead Road, Dudley Street and Stafford Street.

No cyclist shall proceed along the cycle lane between the junctions of Potters Lane and Stafford Street. Cyclists will be requested to dismount and follow the footway to rejoin the cycle lane past the works area.

The purpose and reason for the issue of this Notice is to facilitate urgent access to install a new electrical supply by National Grid Electricity Distribution.

This Notice will remain effective and in force from 1st April 2026 (24hr) and for a period not exceeding 21 days. It is anticipated that the work will be completed by 2nd April 2026.
