

**SANDWELL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – Section 14 2**

**Temporary Prohibition of Cape Hill, Cranford Street, French Walls
Way, Unett Street and Woodlands Street, Smethwick**

The Borough Council of Sandwell hereby gives Notice from 29th June 2026 no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along the roads as advised below.

- Cranford Street, Smethwick, will be closed from the roundabout at the junction of Grove Lane, Soho Way and Windmill Lane to the junction of London Street (north west side) 29th June – 4th July 2026 (19:00 – 06:00 each evening / morning).
- Cape Hill, Smethwick, will be closed one-way in a westerly direction from the roundabout at the junction of Dudley Road and Grove Lane for 40 metres (29th – 30th June 2026) (19:00 – 06:00).
- Unett Street, Smethwick, will be closed at the junction of Grove Lane (30th June – 1st July 2026) (19:00 – 06:00).
- Woodlands Street, Smethwick, will be closed at the junction of Grove Lane (1st – 2nd July 2026) (19:00 – 06:00).
- French Walls Way, Smethwick, will be closed at the junction of Grove Lane (2nd – 3rd July 2026) (19:00 – 06:00).

Access to any affected frontages will be maintained, but only when safety permits.

The purpose and reason for the issue of this Notice is to facilitate access for drainage surveys by Haystoun Construction Limited on behalf of Sandwell Metropolitan Borough Council.

This Notice will remain effective and in force from 29th June 2026 and for a period not exceeding 21 days. It is anticipated that the work will be completed by 4th July 2026.
