

Council Tax - Claim for Discount/Exemption Visiting Forces

The amount of Council Tax payable is based on the assumption that there are two, or more, adults living in each property. An exemption may apply where the property remains empty for the reason stated below:-

If a person, normally resident in the property is a member of a visiting armed force he/she may be disregarded for the purposes of Council Tax and a discount may apply. Full definition of the criteria is shown below.
