

Council Tax - Claim for Discount Members of Religious Communities

The amount of Council Tax payable is based on the assumption that there are two, or more, adults living in each property. A discount of 25% will apply where there is only one resident or where ALL the other adult residents fall into certain categories. One of these categories relates to people who are members of a religious community.

If any member of your household, is a member of a religious community, he/she is disregarded for the purpose of Council Tax and a discount may apply. See overleaf for definitions of a member of a religious community.

Guidance Notes

A person shall be disregarded for the purposes of Council Tax and a discount may apply on a particular day if: he/she is a person who

- A) Is a member of a religious community the principal occupation of which consists of prayer, contemplation, education, the relief of suffering, or any combination of these?
- B) Has no income or capital of his own (excepting any pension paid by a former employer) and is dependant on the community to provide for his material needs.

Please Note: Where there is a legitimate reason to do so information which is collected for the administration of Council Tax may be shared with other departments within Sandwell Council.
