You said:

You sometimes felt isolated and would like carer mentors

We did:

Nominated and established experienced carers to become carer mentors for day, short-term and long-term placements.

"A little isolated at times

You said:

You wanted a 'pamper' and more wellbeing information

We did:

Invited you to a carers pamper event joint at Portway Lifestyle Centre, nominated a wellbeing champion and share regular wellbeing newsletters.



You said:

You wanted to go out for a Christmas lunch as a social event

We did:

Held a sale event to raise funds to take out Shared Lives Carers for a Christmas Lunch.

Developed and launched a new day respite service Home and Away.
We have recruited 4 carers specifically for this service.

You said:

You needed respite care with a specialist provider

We did:

Worked with the Social Work team to consider providers and source an appropriate provider



"I feel we are listened to"

You said:

You wanted a mixture of formats and locations of Carer meetings

We did:

We now hold a mixture of face-to-face and online meetings, including quarterly newsletters. We now have a Terms of Reference in place.







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You said:

You wanted more information regarding Long Term placements and Kinship

We did:

Took your queries to Shared Lives Plus and sought information which was shared in newsletters

You said:

You wanted more information and guidance around cyber safety

We did:

Attended specific training to develop our knowledge and share information and resources with you in newsletters



Our survey says:

Over half of carers felt the e-learning on Care Tutor was not always applicable to their role as a Shared Lives Carer.

You said:

Current online training isn't always applicable for providing care in the home envrionment

We did:

Sourcing an alternative training provider to provide applicable training. We are working with learning and development for this.
